Maunaly Mursday Tenebrae Service First Presbyterian Church of Plattsburgh

Many of the events surrounding the last days in the life of Christ are shrouded in darkness. In the fourth century a solemn observance of the Lord's Supper, known as "Tenebrae" was celebrated. The service involved the extinguishing of candles as a reminder of the darkness that covered the earth after the passion and crucifixion of Jesus Christ. The word Tenebrae means 'darkness'.

The service begins in silence and ends in almost total darkness. The candles are gradually extinguished, symbolic of the gradual flight and denial of the disciples and friends of Jesus after the crucifixion. As we see the pageant unfolding, we are reminded of our own falling away and the consequences of separation from God. However, one light still remains; the light of Christ can never be extinguished. In that light we find forgiveness and fellowship in communion with our Lord.

The candles are arranged so that there is only one central candle, representing Christ and eight additional candles which will be extinguished one by one, leaving the church in almost total darkness. The one candle symbolizing Christ as the light of the world remains burning as the source of our light and hope.

Except for those assigned speaking parts in the service and the singing of hymns, the rule of silence is strictly observed, both on entering and leaving the church, with no greeting or conversation. Thank you.

The Seventh Light- The Darkness of Light

"And this is the judgement that the light has come into the world, and people loved darkness rather than light." (John 3:19)

(During this period of silence, the organ will play several verses of a familiar hymn.)

Minister: Let us read silently together.

Put out the light, Lord, it is too bright. I don't like the light, I feel more secure in the dark. The light reveals my every flaw, my every blemish. I must put on makeup to cover the imperfections in my skin; I must hide behind the veneer of things; I must not show my true emotions to speak without thinking; I must not touch or feel or show I care. Lord, I am afraid to say I love you. I want your warm arms about me in the night, Lord, but please put out the light.

The Eighth Candle- The Darkness of The Cross

Minister: And as they led him away, they seized one Simon of Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, and laid on him the cross, to carry it behind Jesus. And there followed him a great multitude of the people, and of women who bewailed and lamented him. But Jesus turning to them said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me, but weep for yourselves and for your children." (Luke 23:26-28)

Prelude

Meditation Before Worship

Love is captured in feeling, but expressed in relationship. Love is always acted out on the stage of life. The love of Christ is made real, not alone through thought, but through fellowship.
